5 Maritime Schools

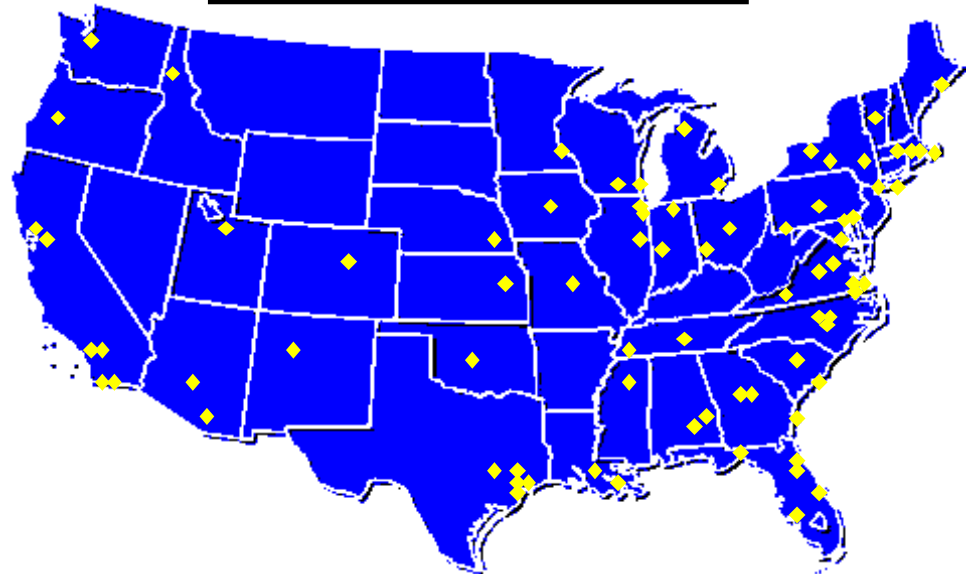
