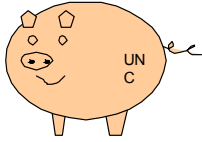

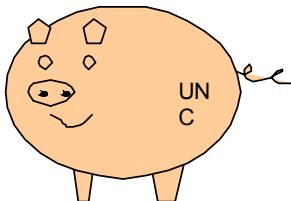
Scuttlebutt


In Memoriam

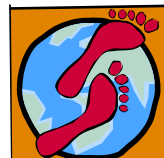

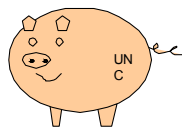

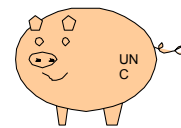
